

# Disabled Digital Inclusion Index

- A measure of the extent to which different countries are promoting and achieving access to and use of digital information and communications technologies by those with different disabilities
- A tool with which to benchmark success towards the goal of relatively unimpeded access and use

# Preliminary Design of DDII

- Legislation asserting steps shall be taken
- Regulations to implement legislation
- Enforcement of regulations
- Voluntary actions being taken
- Encouragement of “best” practices
- Availability of appropriate ICTs
- Usage rates of those ICTs

# Plan for Design and Implementation

- 1. Survey to learn the right questions to ask
- 2. Second survey to learn:
  - What are the most important concerns
  - What are the things that change (the variables) that we should try measure
  - What are the readily available information sources
- 3. Design structure of DDII version 1.0

# Plan for Design and Implementation II

- 4. Acquisition and assembly of data into DDII
  - Official publications
  - Reports and assessments by NGOs
  - A secondary measure of the gap between actual and desired levels of success
- 5. Preparation of DDII documentation and delivery of DDII version 1.0 data to G3ict
